ECTS and grading	<p>Exchange students are recommended to take courses worth 15 to 30 ECTS per semester.</p> <p>The grading scale runs from 1.0 (highest) to 4.0 (lowest).</p>
Transcript of Records	<p>The official transcript of records of each student will be sent to the international office of the home university.</p>

Semester fees	<p>Enrolment takes place after arrival in Mainz on the induction day.</p> <p>All students (German and international) are required to pay a semester fee at this time, which is approximately 360 EUR.</p> <p>The semester fee is a contribution to cover the costs of social care, as well as the semester ticket covering the free use of public transport in the Rhine-Main region throughout the semester. This is <u>not</u> a tuition fee. Exchange students pay normal tuition fees to their home institution as appropriate. They will not have to pay for tuition at CUAS Mainz.</p>

Costs of living	<p>The average budget for living and studying in Mainz is between 700 and 850 EUR per month, but the actual costs of living depend on the personal expenses.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Accommodation: approx. 300-500 EUR per month Food: approx. 180 EUR per month Semester fee: approx. 360 EUR per semester (including free use of public transport in the Rhine-Main region) Health insurance: approx. 90 EUR per month Personal expenses
Visa information	<p>All exchange students are required to inquire in advance whether they need a visa to study in Germany or not. Information on visa requirements can be found here. If a visa is required, the student should calculate at least 8 - 10 weeks' time to apply for it.</p>

Residence permit	All incoming exchange students must register with the local Immigration Office within two weeks after entering Germany in order to obtain their residence permit.
Health insurance	<p>Every student in Germany must have health insurance, including exchange students.</p> <p>Please note that a valid health insurance plan is mandatory for your visa/residence permit.</p> <p>You can find further information on health insurance on the German Academic Exchange Service's website.</p>
